## College Credit Plus (CCP)

Earn high school and college credits concurrently with three options.

### 1. College in High School courses taught by United Local HS teachers:

### How to enroll in CCP:

- a. \_\_\_\_\_ Meet the requirements for “College Ready” as determined by the college.
  - Minimum **grade point average**
  - Minimum **ACT score(s)**
- b. \_\_\_\_\_ Complete the “**Intent to Participate in CC+**” form and turn it in at the UHS Guidance office by April 1 of every preceding the year the student will participate in the CC+ program. (Forms must be turned in by April 1, 2018 to participate in CCP during the 2018-2019 school year.)
- c. \_\_\_\_\_ **Complete the YSU/KSU Application for acceptance to the university/college by April 20** for the following school year. *\*Students must be accepted to the college/university before they can choose to enroll for college credit/dual credit courses. Applying however does not require students to participate in CCP during the coming school year and students may decide not to participate without consequence.*
- d. \_\_\_\_\_ Complete course registration with YSU and/or KSU. *If your student earns a failing grade for any CCP course or withdrawals after the deadline, the student and/or parent/guardians will reimburse United Local Schools for the amount of funds paid to the college for the student.*

### 2. Advanced Placement courses taught by United Local HS teachers: (similar to CCP courses, to receive credit for AP courses, the students must pass an AP exam for the AP course they are taking). The AP Exam is an independent option for college credit and does not impact the student’s grade in the AP course.

3. CC+ at Kent State Salem taught at either the Kent City Center or Kent Salem Branch Campus by Kent State faculty:

Students who meet the college ready requirements listed above have the opportunity to take courses through Kent State University. Course offerings change each semester and students are advised at both UHS and Kent Salem. Credits earned through Kent State are applied to UHS graduation requirements. **NOTE:** Taking courses at KSU (off-site from UHS) could impact eligibility for Top Ten, Honors Diploma, etc. based on those specific requirements. Students are responsible for transportation to and from campus, applying to the University, enrolling in classes and making appointments for advisement.

**Youngstown State University minimum requirements:**

- Minimum 2.0 cumulative high school gpa
- 17 composite ACT score or SAT critical writing/reading and math combined of at least 910
- College ready benchmark in at least one area  
(22+ Reading ACT, 18+ English ACT, 22+ Math ACT  
Deadline to apply: May 1, 2018 (YSU Application day @ UHS-March 15, 2018)

**Kent State-Salem admission guidelines:**

- 18+ ACT English/ minimum 19+ ACT Reading/ 22+ ACT Math  
Deadline to apply: May 1, 2018 (Kent Application day @ UHS-TBA )
